Pee Wee Camp Sessions 1-4, 9:30am-12noon For youth entering Kindergarten 2018 or 2019

For youngsters ready for a camp experience without their parents, but not yet old enough for a full day of camp. There will be crafts, games, swimming and lots of fun with our caring staff. Must be toilet trained. No early-care available.
Fee per session: \$165R, \$195NR
Early Bird rate if paid by May1st: \$150R, \$175NR



Squirts, Juniors, and Senior Camps Sessions 1-4, 9am-4pm Entering grades 1-9

Campers are divided into developmentally appropriate age groups. Each group is led by 3-4 trained and caring counselors who build friendships among the campers and guide them as they experience all we have to offer. Special activities include morning swim lessons for the younger campers, and an adventure field trip for the Seniors. Daily activities include free swim in the afternoon, and activities planned specifically for each age group by Specialty Counselors in Nature/Science, Arts & Crafts and Drama.

All new campers must show they have completed Kindergarten.

Fee per session: \$325 R, \$375 NR

Trips for Seniors & Sports Camp

Sports Camp Sessions 1-4, 9am-4pm Entering grades 4-9

This group of campers swim twice a day, and play a variety of sports that are often modified by former campers & our energetic staff! One trip/session.

Fee per session: \$325 R, \$375 NR

Discounted \$15 per session if paid by May1st

Before-Care Camp Session 1-4, 7am-9am Entering Grades 1-10

For families who cannot wait until 9am to drop their children off. Staff will be available beginning 7am. Bring breakfast and enjoy a leisurely start to the camp day.

Fee per session: \$70R, \$100NR

After-Care Camp Session 1-4, 4pm-6pm Entering Grades 1-10

For families who cannot pick their children up at 4pm. Staff will be available until 6pm for a nice wind down to the busy camp day. Send a snack that is packaged separately. Staff will bring campers to Swim Lessons or Swim Team if they are registered for those additional activities. Fee per session: \$70R, \$100NR

The Health Department requires we have your child's health records prior to camp so that each staff member can be made aware of all concerns **before the session begins**. All forms are available online or in the Recreation Office. *Forms brought the day OF camp will result in a long delay: your child will NOT be permitted to join their group until the list is updated and distributed to all staff.*

Camp Leadership Programs Sessions 1-4 9am-4pm Grades 9-12

Beekman Day Camp is unique among Rec camps in that we hire a Leadership Coordinator to facilitate leadership development in our oldest campers.

- The program is **SELECTIVE** and interested youth must apply (forms are online and in the office) and be accepted into the program **BEFORE** registering for camp
- There are 4 two-week sessions over two summers of progressive programming which must be taken sequentially

LIT (Leader in Training) Parts A & B:

General Leadership Training

Fee per session: \$200R, \$225NR

LITs spend most of their time with their peers in leadership training & team building activities. They do some planning and presenting to younger campers, and some observing of camper groups. All interactions are followed by peer discussion of the experience.

CIT (Counselor in Training) Parts A & B:

General Camp Counselor Training/Interning

Fee per session: \$150R, \$175NR

CITs spend increasingly more time interning with Counselors and a specific group of campers. They return to their peers at least once each day for reflection and a debriefing of their experiences.

RI (Recreation Intern):

Overall Park Recreation Training/Interning

Fee per session: \$125R, \$150NR

RIs help plan and lead the all camp activity, work alongside specialty counselors to plan activities for campers, and intern with recreation staff in non-camp areas!

Nature Kids Camp 4 days, the first wk of each session 10:30am-12noon Entering grades 1-4

For young nature lovers to enjoy time with our Nature Camp Counselor exploring the natural wonders of Rec Park.

Fee per week: \$50R, \$60NR



Playgroup Camp for Toddlers & their Caregiver Tuesdays and Wednesdays, 10:30am-12:00pm

Session A: 6/26, 6/27, 7/3, 7/10, 7/11, 7/17, 7/18

Session B: 7/24, 7/25, 7/31, 8/1, 8/7, 8/8, 8/14, 8/15

Join us for some crafts, games and songs camp style! We are offering two 4 week sessions with 8 classes per session, classes are Tuesday and Wednesday mornings (no class July 4th). This program is designed for toddlers & young preschoolers with their caregiver. There will be planned, guided activities and an emphasis on fun and friendship building for both the children and their adult partner.

Trained Swim Instructors will guide you to help your child adapt to the water prior to them registering for individual swim lessons. An adult partner is required for each child.

Extends through Sessions 1, 2 and 3

Must be able to swim 25 yards

Parents must select a volunteer role to assist the team.

Lifeguard Certification
