**\*Senior Trip Registration Procedures**

- **Who can register when:**
  - **Resident Senior in person** registration begins on the first day of Sign-up at the Beekman Community Center between the hours of 10 am and 1:30 pm
  - **Non-resident registration** begins at noon on the first day of Sign-up
  - **Non-senior registration** begins at 10am in the Community Center on the last date of Sign-up
- To register, an individual must have a 2018 **“Senior Programs Membership Registration & Emergency Information Form”** on file with the Beekman Recreation Department. Forms are available online, in the Rec Office, or in the Senior Center.
- All reservations must be accompanied by full payment, no exceptions. Checks are payable to: **Town of Beekman.**
- No phone registrations will be accepted.
- **Individuals may only register themselves and up to one other Senior who already has a** “Senior Programs Membership Registration & Emergency Information Form” on file.
- In the event the trip does not fill up on the initial day of sign up, the list will be kept in the Recreation Office, where Seniors can go during business hours, M-F, 9am - 4pm.
- Any **cancellations** must be made through Rec Office staff at 845-227-5783. There are **no refunds**, unless the spot can be filled.
- Bus seating is based on the order registrations are taken, exceptions made for people with disabilities.
- Registrants must also complete a **Trip Emergency Contact form** when registering. (Separate from form listed above)
